**Carhenge, Alliance, NE** - A replica of England's Stonehenge located near the city of Alliance, Nebraska, made entirely of cars.

**Rock Springs to Yellowstone** - Enjoy the scenery as you travel from Rock Springs to Yellowstone, where you will spend the night.

**Crazy Horse** - The world's largest mountain carving located in the Black Hills of South Dakota.

**Mount Rushmore** - Featuring 60-foot sculptures of George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, Theodore Roosevelt and Abraham Lincoln.

**Orientation and Communications, Crazy Horse** - The story of Korczak and his mountain sculpture is told in this \$1.6 million center with viewing veranda, educational displays and a full-service restaurant; Indian Museum of North America; Native American Educational and Cultural Center; and Ziolkowski's log home and studio.

**Grand Teton, Colter Bay Visitor Center** - As we drive thru the Grand Teton's well make a stop and this visitors center. Take some time to stretch your legs and take a look at the displays of artifacts from the David T. Vernon collection never before on display. There is also a large bookstore, auditorium, and more.

**Yellowstone National Park** - Old Faithful is a must-see! Along with Artist Paintpots and other

areas of hydrothermal activity.

**Deerwood Ranch Wild Horse Eco Sanctuary, Laramie, WY** - This is the very first Wild Horse Eco Sanctuary on private land in the entire United States. Here, these beautiful animals will be able to live out their lives and be cared for in a setting that is as close to possible like their natural environment... only better!.

**Fort Collins Municipal Railway, Ft. Collins, CO** - Join us for a ride on Birney Car 21! We'll take a ride on this vintage streetcar along Mountain Avenue in Fort Collins. This all-volunteer organization working with the city of Fort Collins to provide a heritage streetcar experience.

**Estes Park Visitor Center** - Known as the base camp for amazing adventures in Rocky Mountain National Park.

**Fort Collins Museum of Discovery, Fort Collins, CO** - This is a hands-on history and science museum, filled with interactive exhibits and fascinating artifacts that tell the stories of Northern Colorado.
